OPENER - CLOSER Basic

Circle left

Kawliga was a wooden Indian standing by the door
He fell in love with an indian maiden over in the antique store

Men star by the right, roll it **once around**

Allemande left the coner and **weave the ring**

Poor ol Kawliga, he never got a kiss

Poor ol Kawliga, he don't know what he missed

Is it any wonder that his face is red

Kawliga, that poor ol wooden head

FIGURE Plus, corner progression

Heads (sides) promenade, it's **halfway** you go

Walk in and square thru four hands you know

Four hands around then **swing thru** tonight

Boys run and **couples circulate**, **1/2 tag**

Trade, **roll** and the corner lady **swing**

Swing that girl and **promenade** around the ring

Poor ol Kawliga never made a sign

Because his heart was made of knotty pine

MIDDLE BREAK Mainstream

Sides face, grand square
