OPENER - MIDDLE BREAK - CLOSER Mainstream

Sides face grand square

*She said now where you been? So I thought real hard

Circle left

That's my story, oh that's my story

Left allemande and promenade

I ain't got no witness and I can't prove it
But that's my story and I'm stickin' to it

FIGURE Basic, corner progression

Heads lead to the right, veer to the left

Couples trade, bend the line, go right & left thru

You flutter wheel then sweep 1/4 more

Square thru 3/4, swing your corner, promenade
